SUMMARY:

The Material Handler requires knowledge of the layout of our storage areas, knowledge of parts produced, plus actual procedures followed for pulling, staging, plus recordkeeping.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Responsible for inspection/care of material handling equipment, as needed.
- Safe/proper operation of material handling equipment, as needed.
- Correct location, identification and selection of customer parts
- Proper handling of customer parts when filling orders.
- Proper handling of identification tags
- Correct completion of customer orders.
- Proper handling, staging of totes
- Immediate reporting of problem areas or mis-location of totes/parts.
- Develop ideas for improvement of shipping activities.
- Constructive interaction with fellow team members, team leader/group leader.
- Other duties as assigned.
