SUMMARY:

Sets up and operates stamping machines according to specifications applying knowledge of machining methods.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Set conditions on press machine using pre-tried settings from condition sheets.
- Load and unload dies from press machine.
- Complete production based on kanban production.
- Must perform quality checks on parts.
- Troubleshoot press and dies issues.
- Document production results.
- Load and unload coils.
- Required to material handle including operating an overhead crane.
- Expected to keep their work area organized and orderly and make sure that
 production parts, tools, test equipment and documentation are properly stored and
 maintained.
- They must follow the targets and deadlines set.
- Must follow all the safety procedures, environmental guidelines and company rules and regulations.
- Repetition of certain steps is at the core of this position.
- Other duties as assigned.
